# **Essay Question:**

### **Introduction:**

"The worst form of inequality is to try to make unequal things equal."

— Aristotle

The 2020 COVID-19 pandemic has changed the way we live and profoundly affected the world economy. Much of the effect has been negative. For example:

- 40 million jobs have been lost in the U.S.
- 3 million jobs have been lost in Japan.
- Over 100,000 small businesses have gone bankrupt in the U.S.
- Between April and June, the GDP of Japan shrunk by an annualized 27.8%, the biggest reduction in 40 years.

Nevertheless, although many businesses failed and many people lost their jobs, one surprising consequence of the pandemic is that the richest people in the world have become even richer. For example, during the pandemic between March 2020 and August 2020:

- Elon Musk (Tesla) increased his wealth from US\$24.6 billion to US\$73 billion.
- Jeff Bezos increased his wealth from US\$113.4 to US\$189.4 billion.
- Mark Zuckerberg (Facebook) increased his wealth from US\$54.7 billion to US\$95.5 billion.
