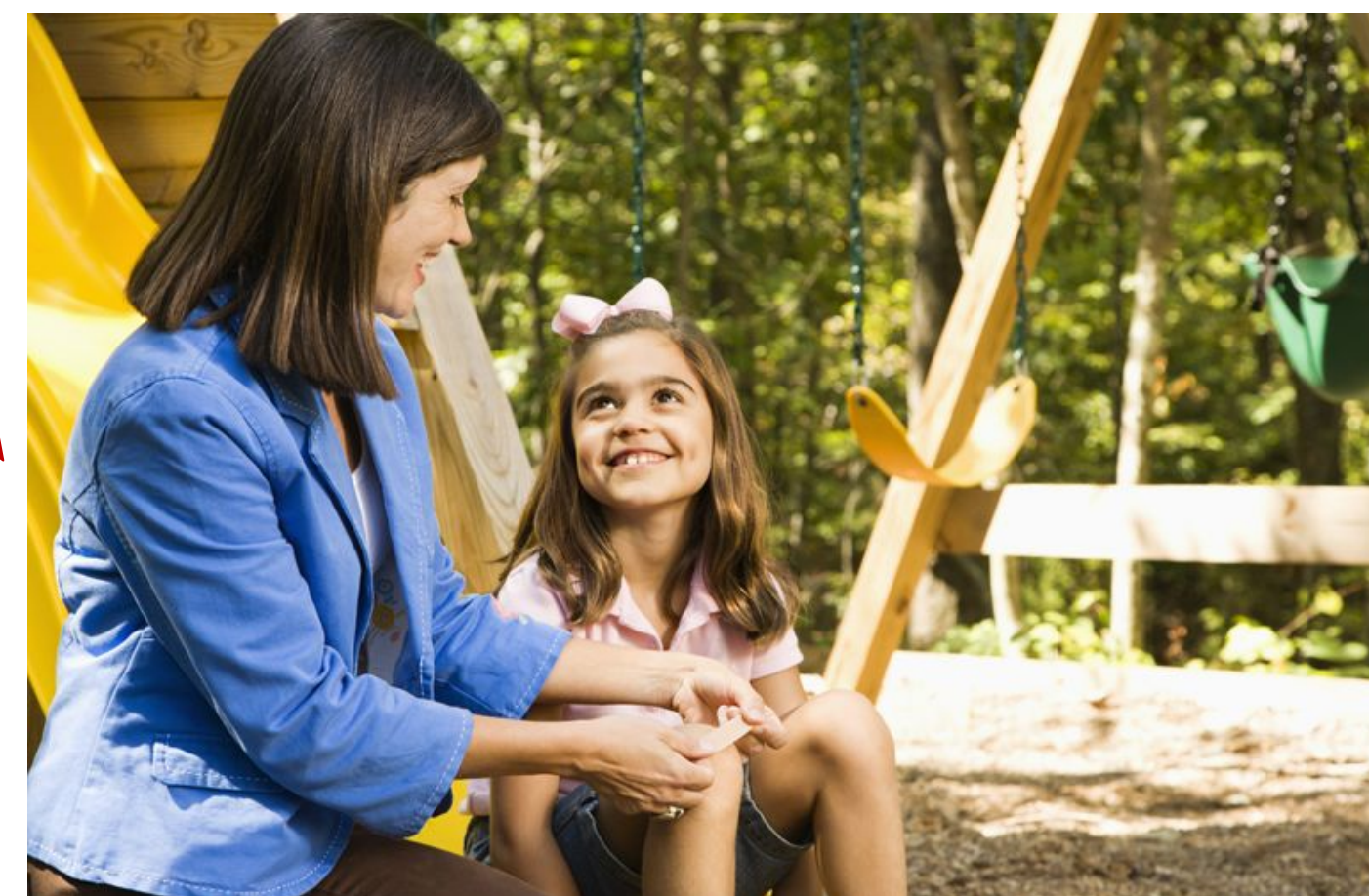


1. What's your name?
