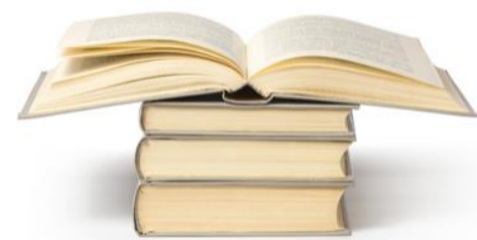
Situation: Those who do very well at something often receive recognition, usually in the form of an award. The school committee are deciding what to give to the student who achieved the highest grades in the school.
