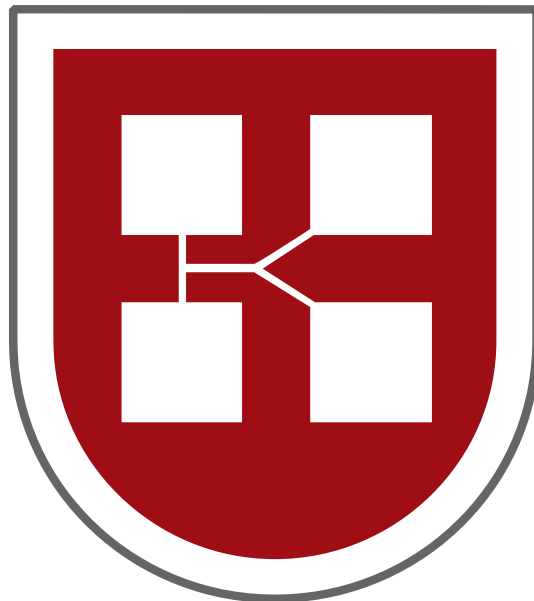

Rosa Parks

'You must never be fearful about what you are doing when you know it is right.' (Rosa Parks)



At one time, many parts of the United States had laws that kept white people and black people apart. Many places were separated, including buses, bathrooms and even water fountains.

On December 1st 1955, something happened that helped to change this. An African American woman named Rosa Parks was asked to give up her seat on the bus for a white man. She refused and was arrested. Some people said that there should be fairer laws. Soon, more people began demanding that the law be changed.

Slowly, parts of the United States began to change their laws. Bus drivers were no longer able to make black people give up their seats, and new laws said black people must be allowed to use the same bathrooms and water fountains as white people.

Rosa Parks was not afraid to speak out for what she believed in. She had a strong character and is remembered to today as a leader who worked for fairness and equality in America.
